Carolina Graduate Certificate in Innovation for the Public Good Community of Practice Requirement

Carolina Seminar in Innovation for the Public Good, 2024-25

One of the graduation requirements for the Certificate in Innovation for the Public Good is to complete an ungraded assignment that asks students to reflect on what you have learned in your CIPG coursework and to share your learnings and reflections with the broader CIPG and UNC Chapel Hill communities. This requirement was intended to:

- Build and maintain collaborations and partnerships in support of shared mission over time;
- Contribute to the spirit of interdisciplinary learning and give back to the CIPG and UNC-CH communities.

To take a more active approach to share learnings and reflections with the broader CIPG and UNC-CH communities we are updating this graduation requirement and renaming it as our Community of Practice Requirement.

For the 2024-25 Academic Year, we will invite all students to attend the *Carolina Seminar on Innovation for Public Good*, with support from <u>Carolina Seminars</u>. We will ask students to attend (3) of (6) seminars at the <u>Junction</u>, Innovate Carolina's space at 136 E. Rosemary Street in Chapel Hill, NC. This expectation applies to all students who are enrolled in CIPG by October each academic year. For students who are accepted into CIPG in the spring semester, they will be expected to attend (2) of (6) seminars for the academic year.
